- 2. USE THE INTERNET...** For repeat patients (verified, 2 or more deliveries), the easiest way to place your order is through the "QUICK ORDER" form on our website. Send us the same information listed above, and **we will email or call to confirm your appointment.** Patients using the Quick Order form to order a day in advance may also be eligible for a special gift!
- 2. PLEASE LEAVE A MESSAGE...** If you don't immediately get through, don't get discouraged. We check our messages constantly, and respond in the order they were received. If calling to set up an appointment, please leave a brief message with the following information: name, city, phone number, date and times available, and desired medications (with amounts). **We will return your call as soon as possible to confirm your appointment.**
- 3. DONATIONS...** Our drivers don't carry large amounts of cash. Please try to have exact change if possible. If you are donating via credit card, please have an alternate form of payment available in case of technical problems.

420 NEWS BRIEFS

- **One Million Registered Patients in USA and Counting...**

NORML (National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws) has announced that they estimate there are now over one million registered medical marijuana patients in the United States. NORML said there may be as many as 1.5 million registered patients in the sixteen states that allow medical cannabis. Assuming that each patient consumes about 1/2 to 1 gram per day, the NORML report said, there may be as much as 800,000 pounds of legal cannabis at any given time in America.

- **Cops Mistake Sage for Pot...**

A Florida bird-watcher was wrongly arrested and spent the night in jail, after local police mistook the sage she was carrying for marijuana. The 49-year old woman was arrested and subjected to strip and cavity searches, before it was discovered that the "evidence" was not marijuana at all, but sage. Charges were filed and the arrest made before the "plant material" was even tested at the Sheriff's Department lab. Criminal

charges were eventually dropped.

- **San Diego Patients Delay New Anti-Pot Rules...**

Facing strict new regulations on medical cannabis, patients in San Diego gathered over 47,000 signatures to stop the new rules from taking effect, filing for a referendum to end what many activists are calling a de-facto ban on medical marijuana in the city.

- **World Leaders Call the War on Drugs a Failure...**

The Global Commission on Drug Policy – an organization that includes former United Nations Secretary General Kofi Anna, former U.S. Secretary of State George Shultz, and many other luminaries - plans to release a 24-page report that argues the so called "War on Drugs" has failed... with devastating consequences. "Political leaders and public figures should have the courage to articulate publicly what many of them acknowledge privately: that the evidence overwhelmingly demonstrates that repressive strategies will not solve the drug problem, and that the war on drugs has not, and cannot, be won," the report said.

please provide us with a pseudonym or alias that we can use.

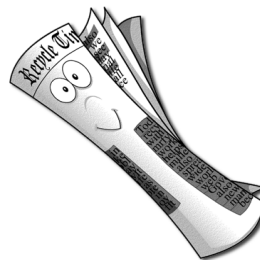
2. One submission at a time. Please keep your submissions short.
